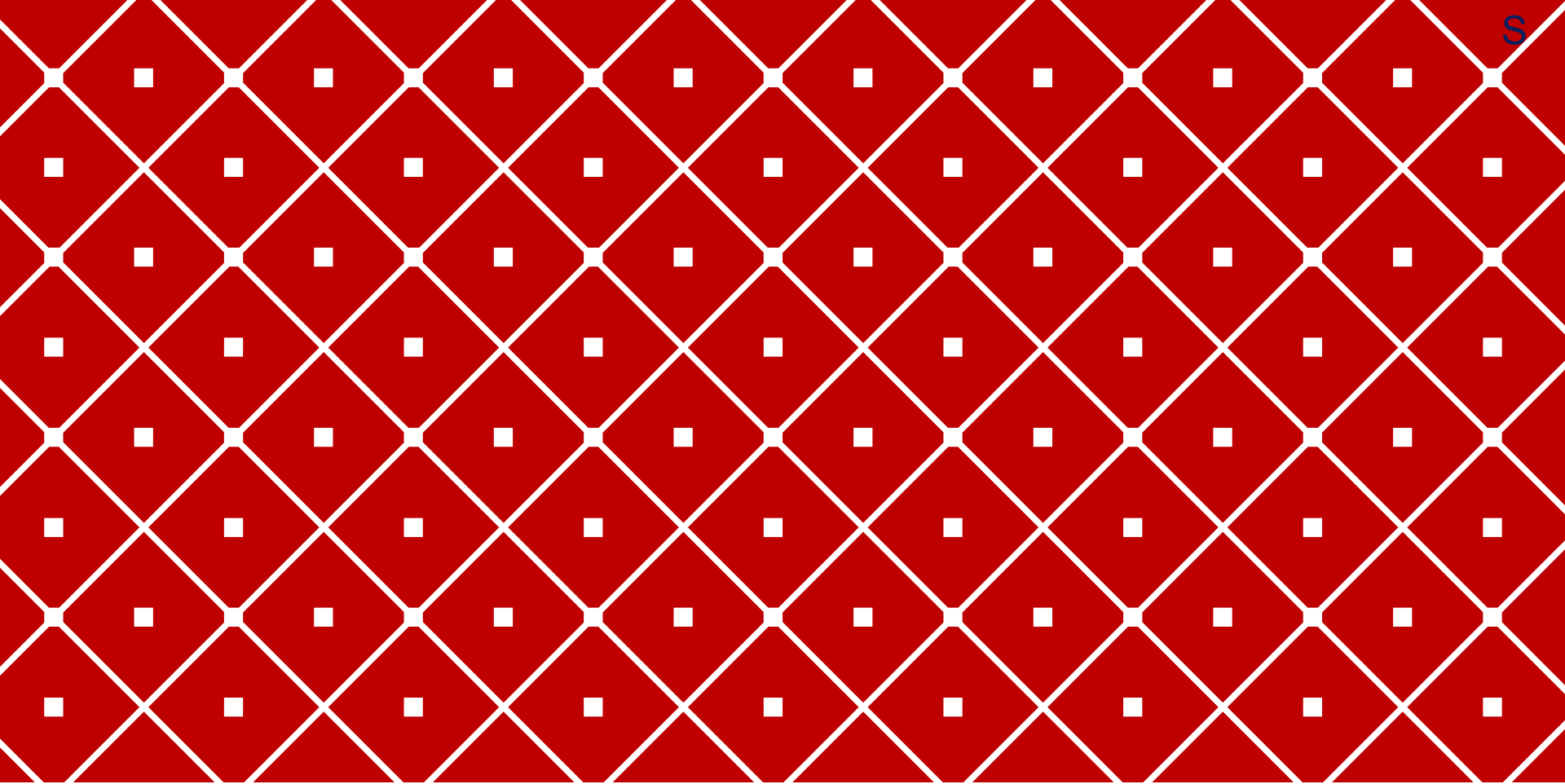
FEES
