The following is important information for the upcoming 2024-2025 school year. Please make note of the key dates and information below and refer to our website for all things <u>Back to School</u>!

- Diploma Requirements students going into Grades 11 and 12 should check to make sure they are registering for the correct courses that they need for an Alberta High School Diploma. A convenient planning document for that purpose is found <u>here</u>. You can check what courses you are missing by signing into <u>MyPass</u>. If students do not have a MyPass account, please stay tuned for opportunities to sign up throughout the school year. These sessions are drop in and hosted by Mrs. Khajavi in the Learning Commons.
- Post-Secondary Requirements students should also check to make sure they are taking the courses that they will need if they are planning to enter post-secondary training. Check the Alberta Learning Information System <u>ALIS</u> or the requirements for many post-secondary programs.
- Career Counselling Mrs. Dion Matheson is our school counsellor and her role at our school includes career counselling. Mrs. Matheson is an excellent resource should your child be interested in collecting some information as well as preparing for Post-Secondary. - 4. Student Schedules Students will have the opportunity to view their schedules on August 19th. Schedules will be made available for viewing for both Junior and Senior High through <u>student</u> and <u>parent</u> portals. New families who do not yet have access to PowerSchool will receive their PowerSchool login information prior to this date.
- 5. Course Selection All current as well as new students should have already submitted their course requests for the upcoming school year. If a student has not completed this process, please contact Mrs. Khajavi via email ASAP (<u>allisen.khajavi@eips.ca</u>). Additional <u>course information</u> including our <u>course handbook</u> can be found on our website. Please

note that course changes can only be made for specific student success planning including post-secondary admission requirements. All requests will need to be made using a google form (more information to come on the process to complete course changes). Each request will be reviewed by school administration and students will be contacted via email with the result of their request. We do our best to complete all student scheduling requests in a timely manner.

- 6. Wait List Students interested in completing a course from a grade level above what they are entering for the 2024-25 school year and have met the course pre-requisites, need to complete <u>this form</u> to request a spot on our wait list. *Please read the details on the form outlining the process.*
- 6. Off Campus Education (Green Certificate, RAP & Work Experience) are part of our Off Campus Education programming. Students will not be scheduled for these courses until they have reached out to Mr. Rempel directly (<u>fred.rempel@eips.ca</u>) to ensure they have a plan in action (ie. current employment with an approved employer). Please contact Mr. Rempel directly for more information on our Off Campus Education programming.
